<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Research a theme and know some of the features of that theme.</li><li>• Create a design making decisions about materials and techniques.</li><li>• Explore a range of paper sculpture techniques and choose methods for your own artwork.</li><li>• Apply techniques learnt to create own artwork.</li><li>• Use mod roc techniques to add texture to own artwork.</li><li>• Decorate artwork using paint layering techniques and pattern.</li><li>• Evaluate and discuss the design process and finished artwork.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children will investigate the characteristics of African masks and learn about their features.</li><li>• They will then be set the overall project task of designing an African mask.</li><li>• They will learn different techniques for building up paper to create their masks and, having done this they will design their mask incorporating these techniques.</li><li>• Once their mask is prepared in cardboard the children will learn mod roc techniques and apply these onto their mask.</li><li>• They will then look at painting and embellishing the finished masks.
