Key Targets and Learning Objectives	Key Activities	Artist	Key Vocabulary
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Know how to use the painting equipment correctly and apply this in a painting.</li><li>• Know how to make a range of brushstrokes when painting.</li><li>• Use a range of tools while painting, such as hands, brushes, rollers and stamps.</li><li>• Be able to make tints using white paint and tones using black paint.</li><li>• Apply knowledge of tints and shades in the style of an artist.</li><li>• Be able to mix paints to create a mixing chart.</li><li>• Apply knowledge of skills learnt in a piece of art.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children will continue looking at basic skills in Art and Design in this unit on painting.</li><li>• They will learn about how to set up, prepare use and tidy away the equipment of painting correctly and effectively.</li><li>• They will discuss the key vocabulary of painting and experiment with a range of painting tools and types of paint.</li><li>• They will explore making a range of brushstrokes and naming these.</li><li>• They will then turn their attention to revising and mixing the primary colours.</li><li>• Once they are confident with this they will explore creating a larger colour palette by using tints and shades of a colour and creating their own colour palettes.</li><li>• They will look at artists have employed these techniques in their work.</li><li>• Finally the children will create a piece of art that incorporates all of the elements taught.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mondrian</li><li>• Van Gogh</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Brushstrokes</li><li>• Thick</li><li>• Thin</li><li>• Dashed</li><li>• Tints</li><li>• Shades</li><li>• Lighter</li><li>• Darker</li><li>• Colour</li><li>• Mixing chart</li></ul>
