<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Know how to create a portrait using correct proportions and positioning.• Know how to use a range of oil pastel techniques.• Apply oil pastel techniques in an abstract portrait.• Know the features of an artist's work and apply these in a piece of work.• Know how to use and apply a range of paper collage techniques.• Design and plan an abstract portrait using charcoal drawing skills.• Create a sculpture using a range of media with reference to design made.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• In this unit the children will learn how different artists have portrayed faces in their work. They will then use the features of an artist's work as the inspiration for their own work.• Firstly children will look at examples of famous portraiture and learn how to position features and create a realistic head shape and features.• They will then look at art works from a range of abstract artists and create a work in response to this.
