Year 2 Block 4 – Line and Shape in Art and Maths

Key Targets and Learning Objectives	Key Activities	Artist	Key Vocabulary
<p>Know that a shape can be split into four equal or four unequal parts and create a paper collage using these shapes.</p> <p>Identify and describe 2D shapes and create a geometric shape painting in the style of an artist.</p> <p>Understand that a circle has a centre point and any point on its boundary is at the same distance from the centre. Use this learning to create an ink and wash drawing in the style of an artist.</p> <p>Draw and measure lines using standard units and create a paper shape collage using these measurements.</p> <p>Identify and describe 3D shapes and use clay techniques to model these shapes.</p> <p>Identify 2D and 3D shapes in familiar objects.</p> <p>Know how to create a texture rubbing watercolour resist painting using vertical lines of symmetry in 2D shapes.</p>	<p>A cross curricular approach will be taken in this block to meet both Art and Maths objectives.</p> <p>Children will look at the geometric shape paintings of Paul Klee. They will identify and describe the shapes they can see including reference to the number of sides and vertices. They will create the shapes and also divide the shapes to show equal and unequal parts. They will apply painting techniques to create work inspired by Paul Klee.</p> <p>Children will then look at the work of Paul Cezanne and/or Yayoi Kusama who used circles in their work paying attention to the mathematical properties of the shape. They will investigate these ideas and use an ink wash circle design in the style of Yayoi Kusama.</p> <p>Having learnt about lines of symmetry in 2D shapes the children will create a texture rubbing watercolour resist showing lines of symmetry.</p> <p>Children will then identify 3D shapes and recognize them in familiar objects.
