<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Know some of the features of the work of Andy Goldsworthy.</li><li>• Create a Goldsworthy-inspired mandala from objects found in nature.</li><li>• Create an 'eco-insect' inspired by the artist Raku Inoue.</li><li>• Know how to use simple chalk pastel techniques.</li><li>• Know how to apply chalk pastel techniques in the style of an artist.</li><li>• Know how to combine drawing inks with a wax resist technique on both paper and fabric.</li><li>• Create a range of visual effects using mixed media.</li><li>• Know how positive and negative space become apparent when using the wax resist art technique.</li><li>• Use recycled materials to create a stencil.</li><li>• Apply wax resist and printing techniques in a piece of art.</li></ul>	<p>Students will learn about the 'eco art' movement and how artists work to promote the protection of the environment, to use recycled materials in their work and to highlight the use of the landscapes around us.</p> <p>Having learnt about the features of the Eco Art Movement, students will learn about the artist Andy Goldsworthy and the features of his work. Using found objects from nature they will create a Goldsworthy-inspired mandala. They will then look at the artist Raku Inoue and the similarities and differences between the two artists. An eco-insect will be created using both styles of art.</p> <p>Students will now look at landscape art and learn the features of this style. They will learn a range of art techniques including chalk pastels and wax resist and then apply these in their own landscapes using the features and techniques taught.
