



## **Student Dress Code 2023-2024**

### **School Uniform**

#### **Omani Boys**

Plain white dishdasha  
Kummah  
Brown or black sandals

#### **Non Omani Boys**

Grey, black or navy-blue trousers  
White short-sleeved shirt with a collar and button front (no polo shirt allowed), worn tucked into trousers, with a belt if necessary.  
Full black, lace – up shoes with socks.

#### **All Girls**

Navy blue pinafore dress (Modest round or square neckline and loose fitting).  
Dresses to finish at the ankle (Slit permissible, no higher than the knee)  
White front button blouse with collar and minimum elbow length sleeves (polo shirts, round neck t-shirts not allowed).  
Head – scarf (optional) in navy blue colour only.  
Conventional (not trainers), flat shoes, single colour (Black or navy blue).  
Plain white or black socks only.  
No make – up allowed.

**N.B shoes (males and females) – High heels, slippers, flip – flops and trainers (except during PE lessons) are not allowed.**

#### **Jackets**

During cooler weather boys and girls may wear a navy blue, black or white sweater, cardigan (zip-up or buttoned) or the school's navy jacket (available from the school shop).

#### **Jewellery**

Both boys and girls may wear a simple wristwatch (smartwatch not allowed) and girls with pierced ears may wear a pair of simple stud earrings. No other jewelry is allowed (**nose piercing is not allowed**). The school cannot accept responsibility for the loss of valuable jewelry items.

#### **Hair**

**Hair dye is not allowed at school**

Boys – short hair and kept tidy

Girls – hair should be tied back

#### **Nail Polish**

Nail polish of any type/colour/shade is not permitted at school.



## Non-Uniform Days

### General Guidelines

Clothes that fit and respect the culture of the community and school rules.  
Clothing must not threaten the health or safety of any other student or staff.  
Footwear must be worn at all times. For safety considerations, all footwear must be adequately secured to the foot.

### Boys :

Allowed to wear coloured dishdasha, Kummah or Mussar  
White/Coloured shirt or T. Shirt.  
Shorts and pajamas are **not allowed**  
Jeans can be worn but **not skinny or ripped/torn jeans**.  
Football shirts are **not allowed**

### Girls:

Allowed to wear long dress/skirt (length to ankle). Short dress/skirt are **not allowed**  
White/Coloured shirt or T-shirt (minimum elbow length sleeves).  
Coloured scarf is allowed.  
Jeans can be allowed but not skinny or ripped/torn jeans. Legging **not allowed**.  
Shorts and pajama **not allowed**.

### Jewelry

Both boys and girls may wear a simple wristwatch (smartwatch not allowed) and girls with pierced ears may wear a pair of simple stud earrings. No other jewelry is allowed except during the National and International Days.

### Hair

Hair dye is not allowed at school.

Students and Parents will receive clear instructions and more details according to the particular event.
