



## TSS Primary Art MTP 2023-2024 Year 2 Block 1 – Texture and Tone

Key Targets and Learning Objectives	Key Activities	Artist	Key Vocabulary
<p>Use everyday items to create a printed repeated pattern showing texture.</p> <p>Explore and experiment with different textures.</p> <p>Create a picture using collage and frottage to create texture.</p> <p>Apply knowledge of texture in a piece of art.</p> <p>Experiment with a range of tools to make different tones.</p> <p>Know how to mix the primary colours to create a predetermined colour palette using tone.</p> <p>Apply colour mixing skills and tone in a painting.</p>	<p>The children will look at texture as a key element in Art. They will learn the language of visual texture and understand the difference between texture as something we can feel and visual or implied texture.</p> <p>Using media of their choosing, children go in search of textures that interest them to take rubbings of. They will use the vocabulary of texture to describe objects. They will then use these same objects to create a repeated pattern, demonstrating visual or implied texture.</p> <p>Children will then be introduced to 'frottage', tearing their rubbings from the previous lesson to make pictures in the style of the artist who created the technique, Max Ernst.</p> <p>Children will then apply their learning about texture in a piece of art, inspired by the natural world.</p> <p>Children will then look at tone as a key element in Art and learn the language of tone to describe. After completing a line drawing of a piece of ribbon, children add tone to make it look three dimensional using different gradients of pencil in the style of Ed Ruscha.</p> <p>They will then learn about using colour and tone.
