<p>Experiment with a range of watercolour painting techniques to create textures, lines, and colour variations.</p> <p>Understand how artists use complementary colours to create artwork.</p> <p>Know how to create a colour wheel.</p> <p>Develop a range of mark making and shading techniques.</p> <p>Know how to create an abstract composition using lines and patterns.</p> <p>Understand and know how to recognize positive and negative shapes in an artwork.</p> <p>Understand and know how to create and use tone and value in an artwork.</p> <p>Know how to apply the skills learnt in a piece of work and talk about the outcome.</p>	<p>In this block, students will explore Pop Art through artists Patrick Caulfield and Andy Warhol. They will deepen their understanding of the fundamental elements of art such as line, tone, texture, shape, colour and pattern, and how to effectively incorporate them in their own creations.</p> <p>Throughout the block students will cover essential processes and techniques, emphasizing good practice for reviewing, selecting, and modifying their work.
