<p>Demonstrated the ability to create one-point perspective drawing using geometrical shapes.</p> <p>Apply the drawing technique of foreshortening to a falling person.</p> <p>Demonstrate how to draw a one – point perspective and understand the concepts and vocabulary related to creating perspective in an artwork.</p> <p>Apply the painting style of the artist Metzinger to an artwork.</p> <p>Apply the thick paint style of Van Gogh to an artwork.</p> <p>Demonstrate a range of perspective lettering styles.</p> <p>Develop a final artwork that shows two-point perspective in a collage artwork.</p>	<p>Students will delve into Surrealism and technical drawing, focusing on developing the formal elements of art, including line, tone, texture, shape, form, colour and pattern, and apply them in their artwork.</p> <p>They will learn good practice for reviewing, selecting, and modifying their work, while gaining an understanding of the limitations of different artistic mediums.</p> <p>Specific tasks will enhance their drawing techniques, and they will evaluate various processes.</p> <p>The final piece will demonstrate their comprehension of colour theory and vocabulary as they create a technically precise 1-point perspective drawing of an interior room infused with surreal elements.</p> <p>Students will also explore how their work can benefit from studying artists like Rene Magritte and Salvador Dali, learning to replicate their techniques, analyze art critically, and use subject-specific vocabulary.</p>	<p>Jean Metzinger Van Gogh Rene Magritte Salvador Dali</p>	<p>Pattern Tone Pressure Line Brush stroke Mix Blend 1-point perspective Isometric 2-point perspective Symmetry horizon line parallel vertical horizontal converging vanishing point Primary Colours Secondary Colours Tertiary colours Complementary colours</p>
