Comparing and contrasting styles from different composers.</li> <li>• Can learn left hand accompaniments (with increasing difficulty) on the piano, understanding musical notation of all notes in the key of C major, and simple root chord progression.</li> <li>• Can sing with an awareness of pitch.</li> <li>• Can maintain a melody line in a two-part harmony context.</li> <li>• Take part in a variety of ensembles, showing an awareness of others.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learn key dates of the Classical period of western music.
