<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Review and reinforce the basics of painting, including colour theory, brush techniques, and composition.• Know advanced painting techniques such as impasto, (thick paint application) and wet on wet blending and layering.• Experiment to create depth and texture in their paintings.• Understand highlights, mid-tones, and shadows.• Expose students to various painting styles such as realism, abstract and expressionism.• Design a painting that draws inspiration from things they have learned.• Reflect on artistic growth and how they incorporated new knowledge into their artwork.	<p>Grade 6 students will refine their painting skills, explore new techniques, and deepen their understanding of various painting styles while reflecting on their artistic growth.</p> <p>Students will start by reviewing basic painting concepts, including color mixing, brush handling, and composition. They will move into more advanced techniques such as impasto and wet-on-wet blending and layering, drawing inspiration from Monet, Van Gogh, and Bob Ross. A landscape study painting will allow them to practice these techniques.</p> <p>Students will create a monochromatic study, focusing on the play of light and shadow. This will help them to understand the significance of highlights, mid-tones, and shadows in creating form and depth.</p> <p>Students will also be introduced to different painting styles, including realism, abstract, and expressionism.
