All students are required to wear the correct uniform when attending school and for all school trips, unless otherwise specified.

**KG, Years 1 and 2
Boys and Girls:**

White, royal blue, green or red T-shirt according to house colour

(Orange, yellow and purple are also used in KG)

Navy blue trousers or skirt

White socks

Conventional white or black flat shoes

(Slippers and flip-flops are not allowed).

From Years 3-13

Boys

Omani Boys – Plain white dishdasha with kummah (to be worn at all times); Brown, black or white sandals.

Non-Omani Boys – grey, black or navy blue trousers, white short-sleeved shirt, button front with collar (not polo shirt) worn tucked into trousers, with a belt if necessary. Full black, lace-up shoes and black socks.

Girls

Girls – navy blue pinafore dress, with modest, round or square neckline; loose fitting, to finish at the ankle (slit permissible, no higher than the knee).

White, front button blouse with collar and minimum elbow length sleeves (not a polo shirt).

Head-scarves (optional) should be navy blue or hair tied back;

White socks; conventional, flat shoes, single colour black, or navy blue).

No make up allowed

NB: : Shoes (males and females) - High heels, slippers and flip-flops; trainers (except during PE lessons) are not allowed.

Jackets

During cooler weather boys and girls may wear a navy blue, black or white sweater, cardigan (zip-up or buttoned) or the school's navy jacket (available from the school shop).

Jewellery

Both boys and girls may wear a simple wristwatch (smartwatch not allowed) and girls with pierced ears may wear a pair of simple stud earrings. No other jewellery is allowed. The school cannot accept responsibility for the loss of valuable jewellery items.
