

## TSS Primary Art and Design MTP 2023-2024 Year KG2 Block 3 – Book Arts and Collage



Key Targets and Learning Objectives	Key Activities	Artist	Key Vocabulary
<ul> <li>Learn how to fold and cut paper to make a simple pop up.</li> <li>Use simple shapes to draw the outline of an object.</li> <li>Learn how to use colour and pattern to make painted paper.</li> <li>Use paper layering techniques to create collage papers.</li> <li>Learn collage and painting techniques to create an artwork in the style of an artist.</li> <li>Combine collage and drawings to make a finished book.</li> <li>Use pattern and shape to add detail to a drawing.</li> </ul>	In this block we will be combining learning in Science with skills in art and design. The final outcome will be to produce a pop-up book about the lifecycle of a butterfly. To do this, children will learn skills in folding and cutting paper, collage and using shapes to draw simple objects. They will look at the work of the author Eric Carle and create pictures for their popups that use the collage skills employed in his books.  The children will look at the books of Eric Carle and explore the collage techniques that he employs, including painted paper, layering and printing. They will use their collage work as a background for their drawings. Children's drawings will focus on using shape as a basis for all outlining. They will then learn about pattern to embellish these.  The final step of the project will be for children to create a simple pop-up using skills of bending, folding and cutting paper. They will cut and glue their illustrations into the pop-up and add embellishment to them.
