### Year 1 Block 3 – Book Arts and Other Paper Arts

Key Targets and Learning Objectives	Key Activities	Artist	Key Vocabulary
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Learn paper folding and cutting techniques to create a simple book and pop-up.</li><li>• Know how to use line and layering to create painted paper.</li><li>• Create a painted paper collage in the style of an artist.</li><li>• Use paper folding and cutting techniques to create a paper collage for a purpose (pop-up).</li><li>• Add design and embellishment to work using patterns and shape.</li><li>• Use shape and line to make an illustration from observation.</li><li>• Use oil pastel techniques to colour an illustration from observation.</li></ul>	<p>In this cross curricular project, the children will bring their learning in English to the art classroom. The end result will be for children to create a pop-up book to illustrate their sentence writing in English. The block will be based around learning the skills of paper craft, design and illustration needed to produce the final piece of work.</p> <p>In initial lessons children will experiment with different mechanisms for creating a pop-up. They will learn how to fold, cut and bend paper in order to create movement. They will then evaluate these designs and choose the most appropriate for the purpose of a book. They will create this and using the criteria agreed.</p> <p>The next stage of the project will be to learn skills of illustration using paint and pastel techniques. The children will learn basic skills in these areas and then apply these to create illustrations to be used in their book. The focus of the children's English work will be 'Space' and so children will create illustrations of their own alien, alien home and alien habits and hobbies.
