Key Targets and Learning Objectives	Key Activities	Artist	Key Vocabulary
 Learn paper folding and cutting techniques to create a simple book and pop-up. Plan and design a series of illustrations for a purpose (Pop-up and book). Learn painting techniques in the style of an artist. Apply painting techniques in a series of illustrations. Know how to prepare and design a printing plate. Know how to create a relief print. Add embellishment to printing and incorporate these elements into an illustration. 	The final outcome of this block of work will be to create a pop-up book for the Book Arts Week Display. The children will be combining learning in English about traditional tales to create a Jack in the Beanstalk pop-up using the techniques applied by the artist Hundertwasser. The children will learn about the artist Frederich Hundertwasser. They will look at the features of the artist's work and focus in on his use of the natural world to inspire his art. They will learn techniques used by the artist in drawing, painting, collage and some textiles. They will then create illustrations using these techniques and reflect on their work. The children will experiment with pop-ups, evaluate these and then choose the best design to be used for their Hundertwasser style pop-up. They will create their pop-up and learn how to plan and format their Hundertwasserinspired work fir the purpose of illustrating their pop up. They will complete their final piece by adding embellishment and pattern.
