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| Student can vocalise with very good pitch matching, good posture, and clear diction. Understand the basic mechanisms of violin playing Read musical notation on a treble clef stave and understand how the notation is represented on the violin Students can play an octave using correct finger pattern in their left and right hands separately, on a keyboard, in the keys of C, G and D major. Students can read some treble clef notation and some bass clef notation on a keyboard Play keyboard with growing understanding Sing with confidence as an ensemble, with an awareness of intonation Rehearse with awareness of group and individual goals | Holding the violin with continued confidence and security Know the names of all 4 strings Place fingers 1, 2 and 3 with growing accuracy on strings A and D Read musical notation with increasing understand.
